

Torah Studies – Statutes #484-485

Statute 484: When a man marries a wife, he is to take the first year of marriage as a special time devoted to growing the couple’s bond of love and bringing each other joy.

Statute 485: During the first year of marriage, the new husband may not go to war, nor be overrun with business. He is to be free at home for the first year of marriage.

Deuteronomy 24:5 “When a man **hath taken** a new wife, he shall not go out to **war**, neither shall he be **charged** with any **business**: but he shall be **free** at **home** one year, and shall **cheer up** his wife which he hath taken.”

- End-time prophetic shadow pictures are found in the TORAH STATUTES
- End-time prophecies will fulfill all of Yahweh’s Times - including SABBATHS and JUBILEES

End-time Events happen on Feast Days: So... The Marriage Supper of the Lamb will be on a Feast Day...

- **Daniel 8:19** “And he said, Behold, I will make thee know what shall be in the last end of the indignation: for at the **time appointed** (H4150 – *mo’ed*, which is translated as “feasts” in *Leviticus 23*) the End shall be.”
- **Daniel 11:27** “...for yet the End shall be at the **time appointed** (H4150 – *mo’ed*).”
- **Daniel 11:35** “And some of them of understanding shall fall, to try them, and to purge, and to make them white, even to the Time of the End: because it is yet for a **time appointed** (H4150 – *mo’ed*).”
- **Daniel 12:1-7** “And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a Time of Trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book... It shall be for a **time**, times, and an half (*in Biblical time, a year is 360 days... “time” is H4150, mo’ed, feast day*); and when he shall have accomplished to scatter the power of the holy people, all these things shall be finished.”
 - The 1260 days = 360+360+360+180 is starting and ending on a Feast Day
- **Colossians 2:16-17** “Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday (G1859), or of the new moon, or of the Sabbath days: **Which are a shadow of things to come...**” shadows is prophetic shadows... So the Feast Days give us the timing and the event of prophecy.

The Spring Feasts were fulfilled by Yahshua in order at the First Advent:

Matthew 27:50-53 “Yahshua, when He had cried again with a loud voice, yielded up the ghost. And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; (*First Fruits Stage 1, happened on Passover*) **and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent; And**

the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints which slept arose, (*First Fruits Stage 2, happened on the 7th Day Sabbath, during UB*) **And came out of the graves after His Resurrection,** and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many.” (*Stage 3 is the waving of*

the Grain, which happened precisely at 9 AM on Sunday morning, after a night of witnessing by the resurrected saints)

When an Epic Prophetic Fulfillment happens, Spring and Fall Feasts roll together... The right Day is the day of the event, but the opposite season will have overtones of fulfillment in it.

Romans 5:11 “...We also joy in Yahweh through our Adonai Yahshua Christ, by Whom we have now received the Atonement.”

- Yahshua died on Passover – a Spring Feast – yet, when He died there were elements of the Day of Atonement – a Fall Feast – all rolled into one!


The Fall Feasts give the timing-events of the End-time Prophecies.

The Mazzaroth – or Heavenly Lights – are Prophetic Markers to help decode End-time Events.

- **Genesis 1:14** “And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; **and let them be for signs**, and for seasons (Feast days), and for days, and years.”
 - The heavenly lights are ordained – or used of God to govern time:
 - The 24 Day is governed by the heavenly lights
 - **Prophetic time – or prophecy is found in the heavenly lights.**
 - The heavenly lights govern Biblical time (the timing of the Feast Days)
 - A year is defined by the heavens.

- **Psalm 19:1-4** “...The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament showeth His handiwork. Day unto day uttereth speech, and night unto night showeth knowledge. There is no speech nor language, where their voice is not heard. Their line is gone out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world...”
 - Constellations were originally called “signs” - **ots**
 - Constellations were originally associated with Proto-Canaanite Hebrew letters – the Hebrew letters are called “signs” – **ots**



The Marriage Supper of the Lamb – The Last Great Day

Revelation 19:6-9 “And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying, Alleluia: for Yahweh God omnipotent reigneth. Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to Him: for the **Marriage of the Lamb** is come, and His wife hath made herself ready. And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints. **And He saith unto me, Write, Blessed are they which are called unto the Marriage Supper of the Lamb. And He saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God.**”

The tenth primary constellation is *Ta’am*, which is now called Gemini. This star-picture came to be viewed as “the twins” because these two *do* look alike. But the resemblance isn’t because they are twins. The ancients depicted this constellation as a man and woman—a bride and


groom. This constellation is portraying Christ, our Heavenly Bridegroom, with His Bride, who are united at the Marriage Supper of the Lamb (Revelation 19:9). The Bride looks like the Groom because, by His Grace, she now fully reflects His lovely Character (Ezekiel 16:14).

Ta'am, the original Hebrew name for this constellation is found in the Bible in Exodus 26:24. Here it is used to describe the perfect fitting of the Sanctuary boards, which were coupled together.

The items which the Couple hold are all significant. The harp is a symbol of victory and praise. The Heavenly Bridegroom is not playing the harp, rather He is holding it, which shows that the victory has been gained through His Power and it is He Who is worthy to receive the praise. The Groom also holds a bow. This connects the Bridegroom with *Qesheth* (the Elijah-Message constellation, showing the white horse and Rider of Revelation 6).

The Arrows shot from this Bow represent His Gospel Message which was "sharp in the heart of the King's enemy" (Psalm 45:5). But the arrow is long gone, for the work of sharing the Gospel is finished. Finally, the spear in the Bride's hand portrays having passed through persecution. But the spear is at rest, for her time of suffering is forever finished. This is the time of *joy!*

Revelation 19:11 "And I saw Heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and He that sat upon him *was* called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He doth judge and make war."



Revelation 19:12-18 "His eyes *were* as a flame of fire, and on his head *were* many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself. And he *was* clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God. And the armies *which were* in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean. And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it

he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. And he hath on *his* vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS. **And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather**



yourself together unto the supper of the great God; That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all *men*, both free and bond, both small and great."

Luke 17:34-37 "I tell you, in that night there shall be two *men* in one bed; the one shall be taken, and the other shall be left. Two *women* shall be grinding together; the one shall be taken, and

the other left. Two *men* shall be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left. And they answered and said unto him, **Where, Master?** And He said unto them, **Wheresoever the body is, thither will the eagles be gathered together.**"

Marriage is the Symbol, in Scripture, of the Union between Yah and His saved People:

Isaiah 62:5 - *"For as a young man marrieth a virgin, so shall thy sons marry thee: **and as the Bridegroom rejoiceth over the Bride, so shall thy God rejoice over thee.**"*

- The Hebrew wedding is a prophetic shadow picture of the Marriage Supper of the Lamb
- The Statutes (Deuteronomy 24) teach that the young man is to "cheer up" his bride (which means "rejoice over" and "with her") for the honeymoon period – so also, Yahweh will keep the "honeymoon" period with His Bride.

As a token of His love for you, you will be given His promise to seal you as His own (Eph.1:13)

"As He rejoices over you, His bride. He clothes you in the wedding garments of salvation and righteousness" (Isa. 61:10).

Steps of the Hebrew Wedding, as they are carried out in the Marriage Supper of the Lamb:

- The Bride is chosen by the Father
 - Deuteronomy 7:6 *"For thou art an holy people unto Yahweh thy God: Yahweh thy God hath chosen thee to be a special people unto Himself, above all people that are upon the face of the earth."*
 - Deuteronomy 14:2 *"For thou art an holy people unto Yahweh thy God, and Yahweh hath chosen thee to be a peculiar people unto Himself, above all the nations that are upon the earth."*
- The prospective Bride has a choice to make. She is not force to marry against her will. She has to decide if she will love and marry the prospective Groom.
- When the Bride says "yes" the Bridal Payment is made.
 - Sometimes it's called the Bride Price... ultimately, it belongs to the Bride. This payment sets her free from her former house.
 - Isaac and Rebecca – Gen 24:53
 - Jacob and his wives – Gen 29:20, 27
 - The more valuable the Bride – or the more in debt she was, the higher the Bride price would be.
 - The Bride didn't hide her Bride price. The coins were strung and worn as a ringlet about her head. In this way she proclaimed to everyone the price that had been paid for her. The Groom conveyed his great love for the Bride by this payment.
 - John 12:32 - "And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all [men] unto me."
- The Bridal Couple then enter into a special Covenant- which is signed – it is called the Ketubah. The Ketubah means "written" and is the "marriage contract"

- The ketubah is the Groom's communication to his Bride. In Bible times, the ketubah contained instructions for the Bride to help her prepare to become his wife. It also tender words of love from the Groom to her, with his promise that he would provide for all of her needs. He would be leaving, after giving the Ketubah, and would prepare a place for his bride, so he could return and take her home.
- During his absence, the Bride read the ketubah to learn his instructions and be comforted by his promises and words of love.
- Once the Bride Price was paid and the ketubah was signed, the Couple was betrothed.
 - The betrothal period is called kiddushim, in Hebrew... it means "sanctification" or "to be set apart". The betrothal was so binding that the couple would need a divorce (or a "get") in order to annul the contract (Deut 24:1-4).
 - Messiah promises He won't break it – John 10:28
- During the kiddushim, the Bridal couple would undergo a mikveh (baptism by immersion).
- A cup of wine was shared to seal the vows of betrothal. This happened at Passover (the Last Supper) and at the Seder...
 - This cup at the Seder is called The Cup of Redemption.
- At the Groom's departure, he would give his Bride-to-be a matan, or a bridal gift was a pledge of his love for her. It was to provide for her during the time of separation and to demonstrate his love.
 - Yahshua fulfilled this by giving the Holy Spirit at His Leaving...
- After the Groom's departure, the Bride was to be busy in preparation for the wedding. She invited the guests, she read the ketubah, she prepared her wedding garments, and she gathered the bridal party.

The Bride-Groom's Return

The final step in the wedding process is Nissuin, from the root nasa, meaning "to carry". This is the beautiful description of the Bride waiting for her Groom to come and carry her off to her new home.

When the time came for the Groom to come, the bride and her bridal party were to be ready - this is the background of Yahshua's parable ([Mat. 25:1-13](#)). It was customary for one of the grooms party to go ahead of the bridegroom, leading the way to the bride's house - and shout - "Behold, the bridegroom comes." This would be followed by the sounding of the shofar.

In Isaiah 25:9, we find what the Bride will say, when she sees her Bridegroom return, "Lo, this is our God! We have waited for Him and He will save us."

Revelation 1:7-8 "Behold, He cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see Him, and they [also] which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of Him. Even so, Amen. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith Yahweh, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty."

A Torah Wedding Prophecy

Revelation 19:7-9 “Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready. And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints. And he saith unto me, Write, Blessed *are* they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God.”

One of the decan constellations of the FOLD (Naveh) is Arnebo, the hare constellation... which is portraying the devil (and all hell with him) as being completely powerless, during the time of the FOLD (Millennium).



Leviticus 11:6 - “And the hare (*Arnebeth*)... he is unclean unto you...” *Arnebo* = “enemy”, “adversary”

Revelation 20:1-3 “And I saw an angel come down from Heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years, And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.”

- The wolf is used in these constellations as a Biblical symbol – wolves conquer rabbits... Also, wolves portray the end of violence – peace and safety.
- **Isaiah 65:25** “The wolf (*Ze’eb*) and the lamb shall feed together, and the lion shall eat straw like the bullock... They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My holy Mountain, saith Yahweh.”

The two wolves which guard/judge the rabbit are Ze’eb (representing Christ) and Shalem (from Jerusalem, a reference to the Bride). During the Sheepfold time, aka millennium, the Bride participates in the work of Judgment:

1 Corinthians 6:2-3 “Do ye not know that the saints shall judge the world? and if the world shall be judged by you, are ye unworthy to judge the smallest matters? Know ye not that we shall judge angels? how much more things that pertain to this life?”

Isaiah 11:6-9 “The wolf also shall dwell with the lamb... and a little child shall lead them... They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My holy Mountain: for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of Yahweh, as the waters cover the sea.”

Connecting the Millennium / Sheepfold with Jubilees:

2 Peter 3:8 - “But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day *is* with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.”

In terms of the figurative “day”, man exists for 1 week:

The time of the sheepfold – millennium – is the SABBATH of the Great Week...

So what happens in a Jubilee?

First Jubilee Event: the Field is Returned to its original owner – the field is EARTH


- **Leviticus 27:24** “In the year of the Jubilee the field shall return unto him of whom it was bought, even to him to whom the possession of the land did belong.”
- **Matthew 13:38** “The field is the world...”

The Jubilee was “hallowed” and “holy”

- At Jubilee liberty was given to all throughout the land.
- Families were reunited and lost inheritance and possessions were restored.
- **Revelation 11:15** “And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, “**The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of His Christ; and He shall reign for ever and ever.**”
- The land was to “rest” Leviticus 25:10-13

During the Jubilee, the Land (Earth) Rests: It rests in desolation (emptiness)

- Leviticus 26:32-34 “And I will bring the land into desolation... and your cities waste. **Then shall the land enjoy her sabbaths, as long as it lieth desolate**, and ye be in your enemies' land; even then shall the land rest, and enjoy her sabbaths. As long as it lieth desolate it shall rest; because it did not rest in your sabbaths, when ye dwelt upon it.”
 - 2 Chronicles 36:21 – tells us that when Judah was captive in Babylon for 70 years, that the land of Israel was “keeping Sabbath” and was resting in “desolation”.
- Isaiah 24:1, 3, 19 "Behold, Yahweh maketh the earth empty, and maketh it waste... The land shall be utterly emptied, and utterly spoiled: for Yahweh hath spoken this word... The earth is utterly broken down, the earth is clean dissolved, the earth is moved exceedingly."
- Isaiah 14:3 “And it shall come to pass in the day that Yahweh shall give thee rest from thy sorrow, and from thy fear, and from the hard bondage... Yahweh hath broken the staff of the wicked, and the sceptre of the rulers... The whole earth is at rest, and is quiet...”
 - What day does Yahweh give His people rest from sorrow, fear and hard bondage? – THE SECOND COMING
 - What day does Yahweh break the rule of the wicked? – THE SECOND COMING
 - When is the whole earth at rest? THE SECOND COMING!
- Revelation 20:3 “And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.” The Mazzaroth shows the




devil (hell) being bound into the bottomless pit in a symbolic way. Hell is portrayed as a powerless rabbit.

Revelation 20:5-7 “But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection. **Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection** (at the *Second Coming, the dead in Christ are*

raised): on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of

Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years. And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison.”



There are two sheep (now called bears) which are decan constellations of Naveh...

Luke 12:32 “Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father’s good pleasure to give You the Kingdom.”

The third decan constellation of

Naveh is Tsiyon (Zion)... the great Ship which represents the New Jerusalem as the people of God.

Isaiah 51:11 “Therefore the redeemed of Yahweh shall return, and come with singing unto Zion (Tsiyon); and everlasting joy shall be upon their head: they shall obtain gladness and joy; and sorrow and mourning shall flee away.”

Job says that while God’s people are in PEACE, in NAVEH, they will “visit” (oversee, have charge over... it’s a judgment term)... What does this mean? This relates to the saints participating in Judgment:

- **Revelation 20:4** “And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: ... and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.”
- **1 Corinthians 6:2, 3** “Do ye not know that the saints shall judge the world? ... Know ye not that we shall judge angels?”


Where will we be in the Honeymoon, aka the Millennium?

- **John 13:36** “Simon Peter said unto Him, Lord, whither goest Thou? Yahshua answered him, Whither I go, thou canst not follow Me now; but thou shalt follow Me afterwards.”
 - Yahshua was taken to Heaven in the clouds before the eyes of the disciples.
 - This is off world – the Father’s House – which fits the Hebrew wedding...
- **John 14:1-3** “Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in Me. In My Father's House are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto Myself; that where I Am, there ye may be also.”

- Revelation 20:4 “And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Yahshua, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.”

Revelation 21:2-3 “And I John saw the holy City, New Jerusalem, coming down from God out of Heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a great voice out of Heaven saying, Behold, the Tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them...”

Jude 1:14-15 “...Behold, Yahweh cometh with ten thousands of His saints, to execute judgment upon all...”



Malachi chapter four also clearly states that the Judgment Fire which God will send during the time of the Bull *Re'eym*, at the Second Coming *Yahweh* will be a consuming Fire. In the third coming – *Aryeh*, His Glory again is unveiled... His Glory is a consuming Fire... All (*the Devil included*) will be fully and completely reduced to ashes. And they will never exist to harm anyone anymore.

The Decans of the Lion are:

- Kos – the Cup of the Wine of the Wrath of God
- Corvus – the Raven, devouring the flesh of the hell snake, at the “Feast of the Birds”.

Kos (Crater) is the Cup of God’s Wrath, which the Bible tells us will be poured out without measure and drunken to its “dregs”. Sadly, the unrepentant wicked, who were not Judged at the Second Coming (*For “the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years are finished”, Revelation 20:5*) will partake of this deadly Judgment Cup along with the Devil.

- *“For in the Hand of Yahweh there is a Cup... The dregs thereof, all the wicked of the earth shall wring them out, and drink them.” Psalm 75:8 (KJV)*

It is unnecessary for any human to “drink” of this terrible Cup, of Judgment Fire (2 Peter 3:9; Ezekiel 33:11). To prevent people from “drinking” of the Judgment of God, Yahshua “drank” of the Cup for us all (Luke 22:42, John 18:11). But for those who reject Christ, they must drink the Cup for themselves. And there is Eternal Death in the Cup.

The third decan is the raven, which is a

scavenger and a Hebrew metaphor for death (Matthew 24:28). Since the wicked and the Devil are reduced to “ashes”, there are no bodies for birds to literally eat. But the metaphor is a warning of Eternal Death.

How can we know that Satan (and the demons) are consumed by Fire? The Prophet Ezekiel refers to the devil as the King of Tyre – Ezekiel 28:1-15 shows plainly that the King of Tyre is Satan.

- *Ezekiel 28:18-19 “... Therefore will I bring forth a Fire from the midst of thee, **it shall devour thee, and I will bring thee to ashes upon the earth** in the sight of all them that behold thee. All they that know thee among the people shall be astonished at thee: thou shalt be a terror, **and never shalt thou be any more.**”*
- Revelation 20:5-6 “But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. **This is the first resurrection. Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power**, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years.”
- Revelation 20:7-8 “And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison, and shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea.”
- Jude 1:6 “And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, He hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the Judgment of the Great Day.”
- Revelation 20:8-9 “And (Satan) shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea. And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city...”

- Revelation 20:12-15 “And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works... This is the second death. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.”
- Zechariah 14:4-5 “And His feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the north, and half of it toward the south... and Yahweh my God shall come, and all the saints with thee.”

The final two fulfillments of the Fall Feasts serve as bookends for the Millennium... They take place on either side of Yahshua’s Coming:

First Coming – Sukkot- Birth, Last Great Day – Circumcision...

Second Coming – Sukkot – His Appearing/Day of His Coming, Last Great Day – Marriage Supper

Third Coming – Sukkot – His Appearing? (a Pattern)... Last Great Day – Feast of the Birds (Death of Hell)
