"The Key of David"



PRIESTS AND KINGS – SESSION 3 KEY POINTS:

- Heaven possesses several spiritual Keys, mentioned in Scripture, which are: the Key to the Bottomless Pit, the Key to Hell, the Key to Kingdom of Heaven, the Key of Binding and Loosing and the Key of David.
- Keys represent having power or authority over something.
- Messiah possess the Key of David, as He is the One foretold to reign forever on the Throne of David.
- Possession of the Key of David means that Messiah has earned the legal right to destroy wickedness, restore Earth to its Edenic purity, and establish the righteous Reign of **Yah** forever.



Key Scriptures: Matthew 28:16-19; 1 John 4:4

Then the eleven disciples went away into Galilee, into a mountain where Yahshua had appointed them. And when they saw Him, they worshipped Him: but some doubted. And Yahshua came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto Me in Heaven and in earth. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them... Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I Am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen."'Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is He that is in you, than he that is in the world."

Who does "David" represent in "the Key of David"? (See Luke 1:31-33 & Isaiah 9:6-7)









Discussion Scriptures:

For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ." 2 Corinthians 10:3-5

Finally, my brethren, be strong in Yahweh, and in the power of His Might. Put on the whole Armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Wherefore take unto you the whole Armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with Truth, and having on the Breastplate of Righteousness; And your feet shod with the preparation of the Gospel of Peace; Above all, taking the Shield of Faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. And take the Helmet of Salvation, and the Sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God. Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance..." Ephesians 6:10-18
