"Law of the Kingdom"



PRIESTS AND KINGS – SESSION 4 KEY POINTS:

- *Yahweh's* Law—*Torah*—is the foundation of His Government on and off world.
- The *Torah* applies to all created beings, including angels.
- **Torah** existed in Eden. It was not founded at Mount Sinai, but rather was repeated (and written) there.
- Layers have been added to the *Torah*, due to sin, which include: blood sacrifices, eating meat, and the Levitical priesthood.
- **Torah** is eternal, but the added layers (added due to sin) ended at the Cross and are not eternal.
- Eden's *Torah* is eternal. This is the *Torah* we are being restored to keep.



Key Scriptures: Jeremiah 31:31-34; Ezekiel 11:19-20

Behold, the days come, saith Yahweh, that I will make a New Covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah... This shall be the Covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith Yahweh, I will put My Law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be My people. And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, 'Know Yahweh: for they shall all know Me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, saith Yahweh: for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more."

"<u>I will remove the heart of stone from their flesh and give</u> <u>them a heart of flesh, that they may walk in My Statutes</u> and keep My Rules and obey them."

Two Conflicting Views of Torah:


Yahweh has a Kingdom—an eternal one. Kingdoms all have laws, which are the foundation of government within them. The Kingdom of Heaven is no exception. The Law of the Kingdom of Heaven, as we will see in this study, is **Torah.**

Torah is the Hebrew word which is translated as the "Law" in the Bible. Covenant-keepers know that the **Torah** is the Law of **Yahweh**. But from that point of general agreement, the viewpoints on **Torah** divide sharply into two divergent camps. To fully understand the significance of **Torah**, showing that it is indeed the Law of the Kingdom, we must first address these two views, to determine which is right, Biblically:


"The Law of **Yahweh** is perfect, converting the soul: the Testimony of **Yahweh** is sure, making wise the simple. The Statutes of **Yahweh** are right, rejoicing the heart: the Commandment of **Yahweh** is pure, enlightening the eyes... the Judgments of **Yahweh** are true and righteous altogether. More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold: sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb. Moreover by them is thy servant warned: and in keeping of them there is great reward." Psalm 19:7-11

TORAH IS PROGRESSIVE




